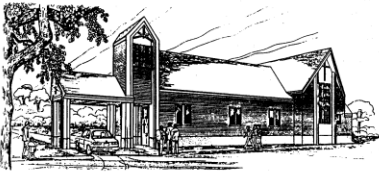

Dear Parents, Students, and Teachers,

Greetings in the Name of our Lord Jesus Christ

Welcome to another year of Christian Education at St. John's Lutheran Church. With the continuation of new curriculum materials from Concordia Publishing House, this year promises to offer a fantastic opportunity for the whole family to grow in knowledge of the Christian faith.

This book contains information your family needs for this year's classes. Contact and other information, such as fees, can be found on page 7.

Sunday School will feature the new multimedia materials used the past two years and adult classes which are coordinated to use the same Scripture texts as the Sunday School. This year, the adult studies have been distributed in a reproducible format which includes a section giving hints on how parents can reinforce Sunday's lessons with their children throughout the week. These opportunities are of the highest importance as the children are taught the faith, and for adults to review what they have learned and participate with their children's education. In all cases, parental participation is vital to the student's success in mastering the material, especially memory work. Please make sure that your child comes to class each week with the necessary supplies and that they do not fall behind in their memorization.

The 3-6<sup>th</sup> grade Religion School students will continue where they left off with the curriculum they were learning last year, which offers instruction that integrates Bible stories and the Small Catechism side-by-side rather than separately, helping the children to better understand the material. Again this year, students will only be required to purchase the workbooks. Textbooks may be borrowed from the church, and are to be returned at the end of the school year. (You may purchase them if you choose, however.) I am in the process of revising the 7-8<sup>th</sup> grade curriculum, and I will hand out chapters as the year progresses. Students will collect these chapters in a 3-ring binder to serve as a study guide. As always, inability to afford the book fee will not prevent a student's participation in religion school. (See the pastor if the cost is beyond your means.)

# Discipline Policy

## DISCIPLINE PROCEDURE FOR ST. JOHN'S LUTHERAN CHURCH SUNDAY SCHOOL -RELIGION -VBS

Due to some problems in the past with the behavior of various students in our classes in Sunday School, Religion School, and VBS we have found it necessary to adopt a discipline procedure. These behavior problems have made it very difficult to obtain teachers for our education programs. It is not fair to the teachers or to the other students to allow problems in the future they will be dealt with in the following manner:

**FIRST PROBLEM:** A warning to the student involved.

**SECOND PROBLEM:** The student will be sent to the Pastor who will remove them from class for the rest of that day. They will be required to sit in the sanctuary of the Church until scheduled classes are over. When the classes end the Pastor will call the parents and inform them of the problem.

**THIRD PROBLEM:** The student will be sent home at that time and will not be allowed to return without a letter of permission from the parents and a letter of apology from the student. The Pastor and the teacher will be meeting with the parents and the student at their home to discuss the child's behavior and what will be done to improve it.

**FOURTH PROBLEM:** The student will be removed from Religion School for the remainder of the year. They may be reinstated the following year but will have to repeat the year lost.

As with any discipline program or procedure the parents cooperation will make all the difference. If we have that support I am sure that we can have classes that will give a strong Christian education to our children.

Completing these sermon notes is intended to guide students to better understand what they are hearing and to help them focus on the Word of God which is proclaimed in the sermon. They are not simply an assignment, but an exercise that is intended to assist them in forming a life-long practice of hearing and examining God's Word as it is preached.

# Service Activities

A natural part of the life of a Christian is serving his church, community, and neighbors. As we have received God's mercy in Christ, we desire to display that mercy for our neighbors through our actions. As the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade confirmation students do these things in their lives, they are asked to submit a report of a few of these throughout the year. They should be reported in the following numbers:

8<sup>th</sup> Grade – 6

7<sup>th</sup> Grade – 4

These should be easily accomplished, since their naturally occurring Christian service to their neighbors should far exceed these numbers. The following guidelines should be followed in submitting service activities:

- No pay should be received for the activity.
- The activity should not have been done as the normal requirement of membership in another club or group (such as 4-H or a sports team).
- The activity should not be related to one's natural responsibility as a member of the family (such as babysitting siblings or helping a grandparent).
- The same activity should not be submitted more than once.

The following are some examples of activities a student may choose to report:

- Help a neighbor with a project where they need extra help
- Offer assistance in the church (folding bulletins, setting up tables/chairs, etc.)
- Help serve at a church function (Harvest Fest, potluck, soup dinner, etc.)
- Help a greeter for church services
- Attend a church council or board meeting
- Help with the church spring clean-up day
- Visit a nursing home
- Ask the Pastor about other ideas you might have.

- Memory work is included in Christian education because it is important that Christians be able to articulate with precise words what they believe about God. Memorizing the basic teachings of the Lutheran faith found in Luther's Small Catechism gives them a tool in doing this.
- Each teacher may evaluate memory work with different methods and schedules, but it is expected that a student complete all memory work assigned for his grade level during the year.
- Parents are encouraged not only to check whether their children have completed their assigned memorization, but also to discuss the assignment's content with the children as they review with the child.
